

This info may be directed to those that were affected by the terrorist attack on American soil on 9/11/01. The process does not take long and may be invaluable to you and your family if you come down with a health issue related to the attack.

Dear WTC Health Registry Enrollee:

The Registry would like to make you aware of important new deadlines to register with the federal September 11th Victim Compensation Fund (VCF), if you have not already registered or filed a claim with VCF.

- People who were diagnosed on or before October 12, 2012 with a 9/11-related eligible cancer (other than prostate cancer), have until the **October 12, 2014** deadline to register with the VCF.
- People who were diagnosed after October 12, 2012 with a 9/11-related eligible cancer (other than prostate cancer), the deadline to register is two years from the date of diagnosis, but no later than October 3, 2016.
- People who were diagnosed with prostate cancer on or before October 21, 2013, have until the October 21, 2015 deadline to register with VCF.
- People with prostate cancer diagnosed after October 21, 2013, the deadline to register is two years from the date of diagnosis, but no later than October 3, 2016.

Registration is fairly simple, takes only about 15 minutes, and is the only step that needs to be done by the deadlines.
